Marge was born in Washington D.C. but moved to California as a small child and was raised in Santa Clara Valley. She started her college years in D.C., first at the Wilson's Teachers College but soon transferred to the College of the Pacific, majoring in art. She ultimately received a degree in business administration at the Armstrong Business School in Berkeley. Marge worked for many years in a variety of management capacities with several expanding start-up companies, most recently with Physics International in San Leandro. On retirement, she moved to Aptos where she lived for 23 years by the ocean before moving to SRC.

Among her numerous travel experiences, she cites a luxury jet trip around the world in 6 ½ weeks as one of the most memorable.
